Question Paper

1) Study Source 1

Identify **TWO** differences between the climate graphs of Geneva and Alexandria.

For each difference explain why it occurs.

1 mark for difference and 1 mark for reasons

2) Read Source 2

Tourism can bring both benefits and problems to the local area.

Describe and explain in detail:

- One social, economic or environmental **benefit** associated with tourism.
- One social, economic or environmental **problem** associated with tourism

Your answers should not be simply opposites.

3) Read Sources 3 and 4 about the recent dispute over Gibraltar and overfishing.

Why are disputes and issues like this becoming more common the world today and what can be done to solve this sort of problem?

You should refer to your knowledge of similar issues to help explain your answer.

Showing an understanding of both sources, describe how the claim made by the Grand Vizier (Source 5) is supported by the facts stated in Source 6.

5) Read Source 7 (Henry Kamen; *Spain's Road to Empire*)

Who do you think deserves most credit for Lepanto? Present your argument, summarising and including as many relevant points as you can, in fewer than 100 words.

6) You have studied or learnt about other major battles.

Write a short essay: To what extent did the Battle of [name of battle, other than Lepanto] cause fundamental change in the course of history?
